Conditions of Entry

- The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the laws of badminton (BWF) except where modified by these conditions.
- Entries are invited in the following age groups, Under 13, Under 15, Under 17 and Under 19.
- All players must be under the specified age on Sunday July 1st, 2018. Players may not compete in more than one age group or team.
- Teams will consist of 4 players in order of strength. Each team tie will consist of 4 singles and 4 doubles with each player playing 1 singles and 2 doubles
- Organisers reserve the right to combine age groups if insufficient entries are received.
- Clubs or Associations can enter more than 1 team per event. Clubs or Associations can combine to form a team.
- Ranking: Players must be listed, ranked and played in order of merit for singles and doubles.
- Each team can have no more than 1 player who has represented Victoria or their State at a National Carnival. These State players are encouraged to play in a higher age group if possible
- Entry fees are per player not per team and should be payed with entry of the team. \$15 per player for Under 13 and Under 15, \$20 per player for Under 17 and Under 19.
- Feather shuttles will be used for all age groups. Shuttles will be allocated for each tie. Any extra shuttles will need to be purchased.
- Players will be called upon to umpire.
- Draws will be available at www.ballaratbadminton.com
- All events will be completed on Sunday July 1st, 2018 and play will commence unless notified at 9:30am sharp.
- Medallions will be presented to the winning team in each event.
- The focus of the event is participation, enjoyment and development for junior players who are inexperienced in tournament play.
